ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

J. JALMS MUSIC AND EDUCATION CENTER, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator for the purpose of forming a not for profit Corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Status, hereby delivers the following Articles of Incorporation for said Corporation to the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is J. JALMS MUSIC AND EDUCATION CENTER, Inc.

ARTICLE II TERM

The non - profit corporation shall exist perpetually. The corporate existence shall commence as of filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- A. To receive and to administer funds and to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation and to give funds and property from time to time to other organizations to be used or held for use directly in carrying out one or more such purposes.
- B. To acquire, own, purchase, lease, dispose of and deal with real and personal property and interests, either absolutely or in trust therein and to apply gifts, grants, bequests, and devises and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation.
- C. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Directors may determine to be appropriate and as are not forbidden by Section 501(c)(3) of the code, with all powers conferred on not for profit corporations under the law of the State of Florida.
- D. A not for profit cultural organization whose purpose is to promote, sponsor, and develop the appreciation, and education of the arts; in addition to encouraging the patronage of the arts, producing artistic productions, exhibitions, and entertainments, and participating in activities that lawfully do any and all things necessary for providing educational and training programs not for pecuniary gain within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE IV

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization except from Federal Income Tax, under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission are to be provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V1 BOARD DIRECTORS

INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Directors of the Corporation shall be elected or removed in accordance with the procedures provided for in the By-Laws. The number constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is five (5) and the names and the address of the persons who are to serve initially are as follows:
