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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WILLIAM C. WOLSKE, CPA, P.A.

The undersigned hereby makes and subscribes to these Articles of Incorporation intending to form a corporation under the provisions of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is WILLIAM C. WOLSKE, CPA, P.A.

ARTICLE II

The corporation may engage in the practice of accounting any other activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.
