ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TEACHING TOTS PRESCHOOL, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I (Name and Mailing Address)

The name of the corporation is TEACHING TOTS PRESCHOOL, INC., and its mailing address is 13468 Palm Beach Boulevard, Fort Myers, FL 33905.

ARTICLE II (Duration)

The duration of this corporation is perpetual and its existence shall commence on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these Articles.

ARTICLE III (Purpose)

The general purposes for which this corporation is organized are to own and operate a preschool for children in the general age range of 2 through 7; to teach children the basic skills and knowledge appropriate to their age group; to provide and supervise snacks and meals; to teach and engage in recreational activities; to engage in such other activities as are incidental to or connected with the operation of such business; and to transact any other lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV (Capital Stock)

This corporation is authorized to issue 10,000 shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V (Initial Registered Office and Registered Agent)
