ARTICLE I - NAME

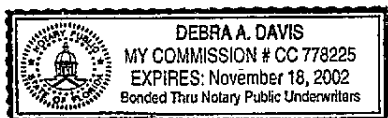


