CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

ABSOLUTE SHINE, INC.

We, the undersigned, in order to form a Corporation for profit for the purpose hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Statutes, do hereby subscribe to this certificate of Incorporation, and do adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be:

ABSOLUTE SHINE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on by this Corporation shall be:

(a) This Corporation is organized with the purpose to engage in the CLEANING SERVICE business and all other lawful activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.

b) To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm association or corporation, town, city, country, state, territory or government.

c) To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain or otherwise dispose of and deal in lands and leaseholds, and any franchises, rights in real property, and personal or mixed property, and any rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes

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herein expressed and to have any and all powers above set forth as fully as natural person, whether as principals, agents trustees or otherwise.

d) To guarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation or corporations organized under the laws of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while the owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the rights to vote thereon.

e) To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock; provide it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock except from the surplus of its assets over its liabilities including capital; and provided further that shares of its own capital stocks belonging to it shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly, nor counted as outstanding for the purpose of any stockholders quorum or votes.

The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation shall have outstanding any time shall be SIX hundred shares all of which shall be of

\$10.00 par value and each of which shares shall be issued fully paid and non-assessable, and shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America, or in service or property at just valuation, to be fixed by the Directors of this Corporation at the organizational meeting, or any other meeting held for that purpose.

ARTICLE IV

The initial registered officer of the corporation is: Francisco Velasquez, President-Secretary, and the initial registered agent at such address is: 3161 NW 29 St, Miami, FL 33142.

ARTICLE V

This Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

This Corporation shall have three directors, initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time, by law adopted by the stockholders, but never be less than two.

ARTICLE X

The management and control of the business of the Corporation shall be conducted under the directions of the Board of Directors by the offices who shall be elected by the Board of Directors, to-wit: a President, one or more Vice-President, a Treasurer, and a Secretary; one or more of said officers may hold one or more offices except that the President may not also be the Secretary or Assistant Secretary. No person holding two offices shall act in or execute any instrument in the capacity of more than one office.

ARTICLE XI

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the stockholders, and approved at a stockholders' meeting by a majority of the stock entitled to vote thereon.

ARTICLE XII

b) To authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property of this Corporation.


c) To set apart out of any funds of the corporation available for dividends a reserve or reserves in the manner in which it was created.

d) When and as authorized by the affirmative vote of stockholders of record holding stock in the Corporation entitling them to exercise at least a majority of the voting power given at stockholders' meeting duly called for that purpose, or when authorized by the written consent of stockholders of record holding stock in the corporation entitling them to exercise at least a majority of the voting power, to sell, lease, or exchange all of this property and assets, including its good will and its corporate franchises, or any property of assets essential to the business of the corporation, upon the terms and conditions as its Board of Directors deem expedient and for the best interest of the Corporation. 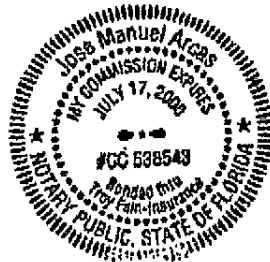
