ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the recommendation of the board of directors, Article III of the articles of incorporation of **YACHTING 4** LIFE, **INC** was amended by the corporation's shareholders. The corporation is filing these articles of amendment to articles of incorporation pursuant to §§607.1003 and 607.1006, Florida Statutes.

- 1. The name of the corporation is **YACHTING 4 LIFE**, **INC**.
- 2. The Article III of the Articles of Incorporation which previously read:
