The undersigned, for the purpose for forming a professional service corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to the requirements of Chapters 607 and 621, <u>Florida Statutes</u> (1997), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

Name

The name of the professional service corporation is First Coast Speech & Language, P.A.

Article II

Nature of Business

This corporation is specifically organized for the purpose of evaluating and screening the child through adult population for speech and language disorders, providing therapy for speech and language disorders and teaching remedial techniques for alleviation of those disorders in accordance with Chapter 64B of the Florida Administrative Code, and for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business related thereto and permitted by law, which shall include investing the funds of the corporation and owning real or personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.
