The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME.

The name of this Corporation is: DYNAMIC BUSINESS SYSTEMS, INC.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS.

The Corporation shall have the power to engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK.

The maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is One Thousand (1000) shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

Each holder of common shares shall have one vote for each such share held of record on all matters submitted for shareholder approval. This Corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE V. CORPORATE ADDRESS

The Board of Directors from time to time may move the Corporate Office to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI. REGISTERED AGENT AND INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.



In addition, the Corporation shall pay for or reimburse any expenses incurred by such persons who are parties to such proceedings, in advance of the final disposition of such proceedings, to the full extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act and/or the Bylaws of the Corporation.




