#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation is Amoré Jewelers, Inc.

#### ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office of the corporation is located at 11362 San Jose Boulevard, Suite 12, Jacksonville, Florida 32223, and the mailing address of the corporation is 11436 Scott Mill Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32223.

#### ARTICLE III: CAPITAL STOCK

- (a) <u>Authorized Shares</u>. The total number of shares that may be issued by the corporation is 100,000, all of which shall be of the same class, shall be of the par value of \$.10 per share, and shall be designated common stock.
