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The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: Corporate Name. The name of the corporation is TDR Enterprises, Inc.

ARTICLE II: Corporate Existence. The corporation shall exist in perpetuity commencing as of the execution of these Articles.

ARTICLE III: Corporate Purpose. The corporation is organized for the purpose of owning and operating a general construction and pool construction business, together with a pool service business and a retail center for the sale of pool supplies, and for any and all lawful business allowed under the State of Florida or the United States of America.

ARTICLE IV: Authorized Stock. The corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of common stock, par value \$1.00 each.


ARTICLE IX: Power to Amend. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

This right may also be waived by affirmative written waiver submitted by the shareholder to the corporation within thirty (30) days of receipt of notice from the corporation.

ARTICLE XII: Indemnification. Directors and officers of this Corporation shall be indemnified to the fullest extent permitted by law.


