



Dear Sir or Madam:

I represent Pier Mortgage Corp. Enclosed with this letter are the following:

1. an application for reinstatement of Pier Mortgage Corp.;
2. a print out from your website indicating the mailing address that had been used when mailing the Uniform Business Reports to Pier Mortgage Corp. in 2000, 2001 and in 2002;
3. a photocopy of page 1 of the Articles of Incorporation of Pier Mortgage Corp. which states clearly that the **mailing address** of the corporation at that time in fact was 1531 Stetson Drive, Wesley Chapel, Florida 33543; and
4. a check from Pier Mortgage Corp. in the amount of \$450.00 made payable to the Department of State, for payment of the Annual Report Fee and the Corporate Supplemental Fee for 2000, 2001, and 2002.

Notwithstanding that a mailing address was stated in the articles, your records reflect that you used the street address of the principal office of the business as the mailing address. For that reason, the UBR for the years 2000, 2001, and 2002 were never received by Pier Mortgage Corp. As a result, the annual fees for those years have not been paid and you have administratively dissolved the corporation.

Please reinstate Pier Mortgage Corp. Because the misdirection of the Uniform Business Report seems clearly to have been the result of error on the part of your office, by mailing the UBR's to the wrong address. I request you to ***waive the reinstatement fee*** in the amount of \$600.00.

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
