To Whom it may concern,

Please find enclosed my payment of the 2001 Uniform Business Report for this year for my corporation. I spoke with a lady today on the phone asking her why this bill was \$550 and she said that an earlier notice was sent out. I just received this recently for the 1st time. I try to receive all of my mail and have been for the last 4 years at P.O. box 1234 Destin, Fl. 32540. The reason I've had problems receiving my mail is that I was staying in a small mother-in-law qts. downstairs and had rented the top of my house for the first 2 1/2 yrs that I've lived here. I had told the post office not to send anything to me here and let the upstairs tenants have the mailbox. Since then it's been a nightmare for some of my bills that they would not deliver at all here. I received a hospital bill after an attorney (collection) called and said I owed some more on the hospital bill. I hadn't ever received this bill before the attorney called and the collection part cost me an extra \$100. The first part of the hospital bill was paid because a man from the hospital called when they didn't receive my payment. The lawyer represented a doctor part of the bill and Doctor didn't try to call, just turned it over to a lawyer for collection. I pay my bills promptly and have perfect credit. I recently went down to the Post Office to straighten this out for about the 3rd time and I believe they now understand that they have to deliver mail to me here. What I am trying to say is that I've already had to pay \$100 because of this post office mistake and now this bill is \$400 more than it was before. I really can't afford that, I am a one man company and just trying to keep afloat. Please accept this payment so I can keep my corporation going. The lady on the phone said to look for this in January. I made a note on this return to send all future correspondence to my P.O. box. and I will be looking for it this January and will pay it promptly. This would really help.
