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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is ROBERT T. TERENZIO, P.A.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles with the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation shall be and is to engage in every aspect of the general practice of law. 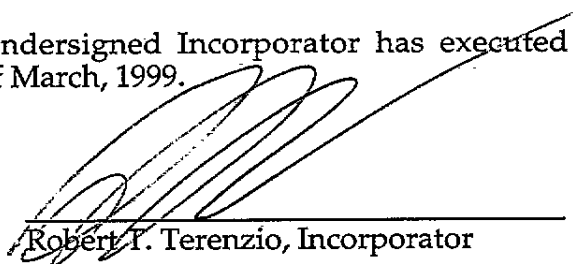
ARTICLE IX - INDEMNIFICATION

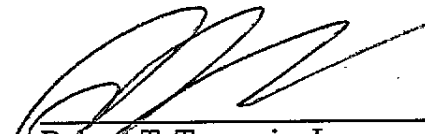
