
The taxpayer is in receipt of your notice of administrative dissolution effective October 4, 2002. The taxpayer never received the 2001 or 2002 Uniform Business Report. When this corporation was initially formed, the name was setup as Robertson Properties, Inc. as there was another corporation with the name of Roberson Realty & Appraising, Inc. After the new corporation of Robertson Properties was setup, the attorney requested a name change to Robertson Realty & Appraising, Inc and the old corporation name was changed to Robertson Properties, Inc. The stockholders in the new corporation were Charles Robertson and Robert G. Robertson; whereas, the old corporation's only stockholder was Charles Robertson. Charles Robertson, the founding stockholder, was the one who took care of corporate matters. In fact, Robert G. Robertson became a shareholder when the new corporation was formed and had never been a shareholder in a corporation. Within months after forming the new corporation, Charles Robertson unexpectedly passed away and Robert G. Robertson became the sole shareholder.

The name change seemed to cause some problems with the paperwork. In 2001, when I was reviewing other problems caused by the name change we realized that the 2001 Uniform Business Report had not been filed so we used a blank form. I told the taxpayer that he would automatically receive the 2002 form the following year. He never received the form as he always calls to find out what to do with any tax forms. Our clients normally just sign the forms and attach the required payment. He received no correspondence until the notice of dissolution.

Based upon the facts and circumstances presented above, we respectfully request that the reinstatement fee be waived. He is enclosing the completed form along with a check for \$150.
