ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned being duly certified and licensed to engage in the practice of law within the State of Florida adopts the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of forming a professional service corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of this corporation shall be;

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The corporation shall have a perpetual existence and shall begin the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Department of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation, or the objects or purposes of the corporation, shall be as follows, to wit:

(a) To engage solely and specifically in the practice of law.
