ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

99 AFR 25 Pil 3: 42

OF

IMMATERIAL GOODS, INC.

The undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is IMMATERIAL GOODS, INC.

ARTICLE II - Principal Office and Mailing Address of the Corporation

The address of the principal office of the corporation is 6209 South Russell Street, Tampa, Florida 33611, and its mailing address is the same.

ARTICLE III - Duration

The corporation shall exist perpetually thereafter until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IV - Purpose

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE V - Stock

The corporation is authorized to issue 100 shares of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) par value common stock, which shares shall be designated "Common Shares."


