ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TPS PRESCRIPTION SERVICES, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the R Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

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Article I Name

Section 1.1. Name. The name of this corporation shall be TPS Prescription Services, Inc.

Article II Principal Office and Mailing Address

<u>Section 2.1</u>. <u>Principal Office and Mailing Address</u>. The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 8286 Western Way Circle, Suite C2-B, Jacksonville, Florida 32256.

Article III Capital Stock

<u>Section 3.1.</u> <u>Capital Stock</u>. The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is Seven Thousand (7,000) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

<u>Section 6.1.</u> <u>Duration</u>. This corporation shall exist perpetually.
