ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JHJ CONSULTING, INC.

TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as sole incorporator, desiring to form a corporation for profit pursuant to the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation shall be JHJ Consulting, Inc.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall begin its corporate existence as of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation and shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III - GENERAL PURPOSES

The general purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be:

- (1) To manufacture, construct, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with products, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property and services of every kind, class and description.
- (2) It is intended that the corporation is organized for and may conduct and transact any and all lawful business authorized and not prohibited by the Florida General Corporation Act, as the same may be from time to time amended; provided, however, that notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, the corporation is not hereby authorized to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative association, fraternal benefit society, state fair, or exposition business.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of share of capital stock that the corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding is ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND (100,000) shares, which shall be designated as Common Shares with a par value of one cent (\$.01) per share.

ARTICLE V - INFTIAL REGISTERED OFFICE, PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND REGISTERED AGENT

The initial street address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Florida and the principal place of business for the corporation is 9242 Ridge Pine Trail, Orlando, Fl 32819. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation as such address is Sylvester Lee Brown.

ARTICLE VI - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. The initial number of directors of the corporation shall be one.
- B. The number of directors of the corporation may be increased or decreased from time to time pursuant to By-Laws adopted by the shareholders, but shall never bee less than the minimum number of directors required by law.
- C. The name and address of the initial member of the Board of Directors, who shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and have qualified are:

ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION
