

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR CENTER FOR CAREER STUDIES, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation in accordance with Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts and files the following Articles of Incorporation.

#### Article One NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

## Article Two PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF CORPORATION

The street address of the principal place of business of the corporation shall be 108 N. Magnolia Avenue, Suite 404, Ocala, Florida 34475. The mailing address of the corporation shall be Post Office Box 940944, Maitland, Florida 32794-0944.

### Article Three PURPOSE

The corporation is formed for the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes.
