ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SOUTHWEST ACRES, INC.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The NAME of this corporation shall be: SOUTHWEST ACRES, INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation is to exist PERPETUALLY, commencing at 12:01 A.M., JULY 1, 1999.

ARTICLE III

NATURE OF BUSINESS
