The undersigned, acting as general incorporator under statutory provisions of the Florida General Corporation Act (Chapter 607, Florida Statutes) hereby declares, adopts, ratifies, and gives notice of the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I: Name and Principal Place of Business

The name of this corporation is RedKight International, Inc. The initial principal place of business shall be c/o Richard E. Enright, Esq., 1463 Troon Circle, Palm City, FL 34990 (561-283-2489).

ARTICLE II: Commencement and Duration

This Corporation shall commence in existence on the date last hereinappearing. If filing is delayed so that more than five (5) days have elapsed from said date hereof and the filing by the Secretary of State, then in that event this Corporation shall be deemed to have commenced on that date five (5) days prior to its being filed with the Secretary. Anything to the contrary contained herein notwithstanding, it is the incorporator's intent that this Corporation commence in existence upon the date last hereinappearing, being the date of actual creation.
