## <u> Article I - Name</u>

The name of this corporation is Victor M. Watson, P.A. and its principal office is located at 1970 Michigan Avenue, Building C, Cocoa, Florida.

## Article II - Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually. The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be the date these articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

## Article III - Purpose
