Dear Dept. of Revenue,

I have maintained the bookkeeping for John J. Jackson d/b/a. J.J.'s Paint & Body Shop for four and a half years. We incorporated in July of 1999. In that same year J.J.'s wife was diagnosed with cancer. For nearly a year J.J. took care of his wife and was also diagnosed with cancer but neglected his health and his business until she died a year ago.

I see John quarterly to pick up and then deliver his bookkeeping. Sometimes I just leave written instructions for the payroll reports that must be signed, paid and mailed.
