I have maintained the bookkeeping for John J. Jackson d/b/a. J.J.'s Paint & Body Shop for four and a half years. We incorporated in July of 1999. In that same year J.J.'s wife was diagnosed with cancer. For nearly a year J.J. took care of his wife and was also diagnosed with cancer but neglected his health and his business until she died a year ago.


I see John quarterly to pick up and then deliver his bookkeeping. Sometimes I just leave written instructions for the payroll reports that must be signed, paid and mailed. On April 5th, 2001, I gave John his Federal Tax Return to mail before the 15th of April. I also left the annual corporate report and told him it must be paid and mailed before May first. The bank account was very low and he wanted to wait a few weeks before sending the corporate report. In the meantime he misplaced the report and it wasn't until July when I picked up the bookkeeping that I discovered the late notice.

As you can imagine, John has been under a great deal of stress, both physically and financially. He in no way intended to avoid paying the annual fee, and I feel equally responsible because I did not realize what a difficult time he was having and I should have followed up to make sure he mailed his report on time.

We are enclosing a check for \$150.00 and amending his report to include his two employees as officers of the corporation. With their help and if you will allow us to retain corporation status, we hope to rebuild this business.
