Dear Mr. Dunlap,

Thank you for taking my call today. The letter my client sent in to you was at the time it was written complete, correct, and true to the best of his knowledge and my knowledge. He did not recall ever receiving a form from your office. After speaking to your staff, it became apparent that the 2000 Annual Report form was sent in by my client to your office with the appropriate fee of \$150.00, but without the federal employer identification number on the form. My client does not recall ever receiving the March 17, 2000 request from the Department of State for his federal employer identification number that you told me about.

As a result, my client did not receive an annual report for 2001, because his corporation had already been dissolved. When checking the internet, it appeared that two years reports had not been filed. Since my client was not aware of anything to the contrary, he and I felt very comfortable and justified in phrasing the original letter to your office as we did. It turns out that the annual report for 2000 must have been received by my client because he paid the fee. The follow up correspondence from your office apparently was never received by my client.

With all due respect, and with hat in hand, we have enclosed a check payable to the Department of State in the amount of \$158.75, representing the annual fee of \$150.00 for the year 2001, and for the certificate of status fee of \$8.75.


Please accept our report and our payment as payment in full as my client did not receive your March 17, 2000 letter requesting additional information. Thank you for your consideration and cooperation in this matter.
