ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE UNDERSIGNED, MARC B. COHEN, acknowledges and files in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, these Articles of Incorporation, as by law provided.

I. NAME: The name of this corporation shall be:

AMERICAN HOBBYIST INSURANCE, INC.

II. BUSINESS PURPOSE: The general nature of the business and businesses to be transacted are as follows: To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida or the United States.

Without in any way limiting any of the objects and powers of the corporation, it is expressly declared and provided that the corporation, to carry out its business, or for the purpose of accomplishing any of the objects hereinabove mentioned, shall have the power to make and perform contracts of any kind or description, to do any and all other acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, either as principal, agent, or broker, conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon corporations formed under the laws of said state, and which now or may hereafter be authorized by law.

III. CAPITALIZATION: The authorized capital stock of this corporation shall consist of one thousand shares of common stock, \$1.00 par value.

IV. EXISTENCE: The business of the corporation shall commence on the 1st day of September, 1999, and the corporation shall have perpetual existence.

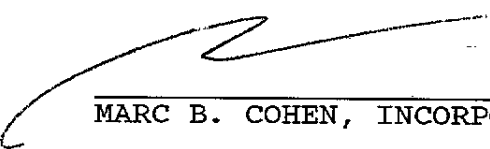
VIII. BYLAWS: The bylaws of this corporation may be adopted, altered, amended or repealed by either the stockholders or the directors.

the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in accordance with the provisions of the Florida General Corporation Act.

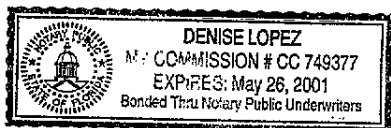

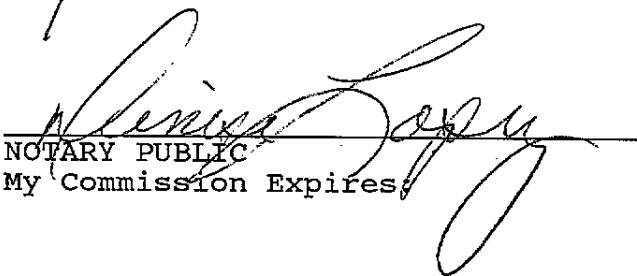
