ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JIM HEPP AND ASSOCIATES, INC.

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The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter 607 of the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "JIM HEPP AND ASSOCIATES, INC."

ARTICLE II, PRINCIPLE OFFICE

The principal office and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 1461 IRMA RD., EUSTIS, FLORIDA 32726

ARTICLE III, NATURE OF BUSINESS

The corporation may engage or transact in any or all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida or any other state, country, territory or nation.

ARTICLE IV, CAPITAL STOCK

The corporation will have the authority, acting by its board of directors, to issue not more than one thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having a par value of one dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE & AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1461 IRMA RD, EUSTIS, FLORIDA 32726 and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at that address is **James M. Hepp**.

ARTICLE VI, LIMITATION OF DIRECTOR LIABILITY

A director is not personally liable for monetary damages to the corporation or any other person for any statement, vote, decision, or failure to act, regarding corporate management or policy, by a director, unless:

- a. The director breached or failed to perform his duties as a director; and
- b. The director's breach of, or failure to perform, those duties constitute:

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- (1) A violation of the criminal law, unless the director had reasonable cause to believe his conduct was lawful or had no reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful. A judgment or other final adjudication against a director in any criminal proceeding for a violation of the criminal law estops that director from contesting the fact that his breach, or failure to perform, constitutes a violation of criminal law; but does not estop the director from establishing that he had reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was lawful or had no reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was unlawful;
- (2) A transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit, either directly or indirectly;
- (3) A circumstance under which the liability provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act Section 607.0834 are applicable;
- (4) In a proceeding by or in the right of the corporation to procure a judgment in its favor or by or in the right of a shareholder, conscious disregard of the best interest of the corporation; or willful misconduct; or
- (5) In proceeding by or in the right of someone other than the corporation or a shareholder, recklessness or an act or omission which was committed in bad faith or with malicious purpose or in a manner exhibiting wanton and willful disregard of human rights, safety, or property.

The limitation of director liability will be consistent with the Florida Business Corporation Act, as the same may be from time to time amended.

ARTICLE VII, DIRECTORS

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the corporation managed under the direction of its Board of Directors, subject to any limitation set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. This corporation shall have one (1) Director, initially. The name and address of the initial member of the Board of Directors is:
