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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
PARADISE LANDSCAPING SERVICES, INC.

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For the purpose of forming a corporation under Ch.607 of the Florida General Corporation Act, is respectfully requested of the Secretary of State the approval of such incorporation under the following Articles.

ARTICLE 1

The name of this corporation shall be PARADISE LANDSCAPING SERVICES, INC., and its principal place of business shall be in South Florida with the right to move said principal place of business and establish other places of business within or without the State of Florida as the Board of Directors may from time to time deem proper.

ARTICLE 11

ARTICLE XIII

The shareholders of this corporation shall have the right to dissent from any corporate actions from which shareholders are entitled to dissent under the Florida General Corporation Act, even though on the date fixed to determine the shareholders entitled to vote on such corporate actions, the shares of this corporation were registered on a national securities exchange or held by not less than 2,000 shareholders.

ARTICLE XIV

SHAREHOLDERS MEETING REQUIRED

Any action of the shareholders of this corporation must be taken at a meeting of the shareholders of this corporation, duly called as provided by law, except as provided for in Article XII.
