ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
TRUMBID.COM, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STATE

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 607, Fla. Stat., the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby states the following:

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

Section 1. The name of the Corporation shall be Trumbid.com, Inc.

Section 2. The initial principal office and the initial mailing address of the Corporation shall be 950 Missouri Avenue, North, Largo, Florida 33770.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence beginning on the date these Articles are filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND POWERS

Section 1. The Corporation is formed for the purpose of engaging in any lawful activity or business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida.

Section 2. The Corporation may exercise all powers, rights and privileges conferred on corporations pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The authorized capital stock of the Corporation shall be Seven Thousand Five Hundred (7,500) shares of Common Stock.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, the members of which shall be hereinafter referred to as Directors.

Section 2. The number of Directors shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall not be less than one (1).

Section 3. Directors shall be elected and hold office as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI - BYLAWS

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Section 1. The Board of Directors shall adopt Bylaws for the Corporation at an organizational meeting of the Board of Directors following the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

Section 2. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws of the Corporation may be exercised by the Board of Directors or the stockholders in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaws.

Section 3. Any Bylaws adopted by the Board of Directors or by the stockholders may be altered, amended or repealed by the other group; provided, however, that any Bylaw adopted by the stockholders may provide that it shall be altered, amended, or repealed only by the stockholders.

ARTICLE VII - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

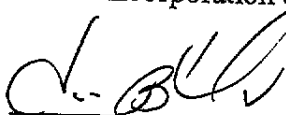
Section 1. The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 950 Missouri Avenue, North, Largo, Florida 33770.

The name and address of the incorporator is Joseph M. Bartholomew, 950 Missouri Avenue, North, Largo, Florida 33770.

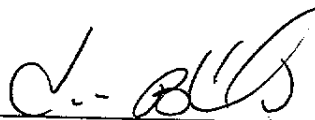
