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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
EQUAL ACCESS, INC.**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of EQUAL ACCESS, INC. under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:


ARTICLE IX. BYLAWS


