

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

COYOTE PRESS PUBLISHER, INC.



The undersigned, acting as incorporator, hereby forms a corporation for profit pursuant to Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be Coyote Press Publisher, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The general purpose for which this Corporation is organized shall be to publish, distribute and market books and to conduct and transact any and all lawful business authorized or not prohibited by Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, as the same may be from time to time amended.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of this Corporation shall be located at 1655 E. Semoran Boulevard, Suite 19, Apopka, Florida 32703.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of capital stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is Five Hundred (500) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE V - GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- A. To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of distributing, marketing and publishing books and any other profitable venture.
- B. To invest the funds of this corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investment, and to own real and personal property whether or not such property is necessary for the rendering of professional services.
- C. To do anything necessary and proper for the accomplishment or furtherance of any of the purposes or objectives of the corporation enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereof, and to do any act necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation.
- D. It is intended that this corporation may conduct and transact any business lawfully authorized and not prohibited by Chapter 607 and Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as the same may be from time to time amended.

ARTICLE VI - INDEMNIFICATION

This Corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE VII - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

AND REGISTERED AGENT

The initial street address of the registered office of this Corporation in the State of Florida shall be 1061 Maitland Center Commons, Maitland, Florida 32751. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the registered office to any other address in Florida. The name of the initial registered agent of this Corporation at that address is Steven H. Kane. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate a new registered agent.
