This Article pertaining to preemptive rights may not be amended or deleted without the unanimous vote of the shareholders of each affected class.

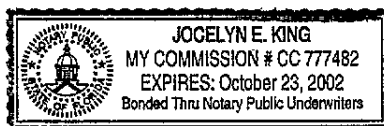
