ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GRAND HORIZON HOMES, INC.



ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation shall be GRAND HORIZON HOMES, INC. The mailing address and the principal office address of the corporation is 7645 Green Slope Drive, Zephyrhills, Florida 33541.

ARTICLE II - Duration

The corporation is to have perpetual existence, commencing with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III - Purpose

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

- (a) To engage in the development and sale of individual mobile home lots and the sale of mobile home lots improved with mobile homes or modular homes placed thereon.
- (b) To engage in any other business or economic pursuit not prohibited by the laws of the State of Florida.
- (d) To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attaining of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers enumerated in this Certificate of Incorporation necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and in general, either

ARTICLE IV - Capital Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue one thousand (1,000) shares of One Dollar and 00/100 Dollars (\$1.00) par value common stock. The whole or any part of the capital stock of this corporation shall be payable in cash, or property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Directors. Property or labor may also be purchased with the capital stock at such valuation as shall be fixed by the Directors.

ARTICLE V - Preemptive Rights

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.
