We found out that our company was dissolved by the Department of State through a third party. In the process of obtaining credit from a fuel company (Costa Oil), they called the Department of State for verification of our company, and gave notice to us that we had been dissolved. We contacted our accountant, and she acknowledged that in fact we had been dissolved. At this point we took matters into our hands and called the Department of State (spoke to Cathy) to reinstate our company. In the past we have had serious problems with our correspondence getting to our address, there is another 12140 number down the street to which the letters are taken, and the owners probably discard the letters. As a matter of fact we have downloaded the different forms for the corporation filing from the Internet, because we never received them on the mail, the state has records of this. We sent the payment of the fee imposed by the Department of State on time, but the accountant forgot to write the Federal Employer number, and the checks were returned. We believe 3 letters were sent to us, one notice of missing payment, one warning of dissolution, one of dissolution, of these we only received the one for payment which was taken immediately to our accountant for clarification. We trusted that our accountant

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would take care of the situation but she never did. We were paying her weekly to take care of all aspects related to accounting, but the accountant was irresponsible and claims no responsibility for this event. In summary, we did not receive all the letters of notice, and the one that we did receive was taken to our accountant, but she failed to resubmit the necessary information. We are a small company with major financial problems, that is the reason we kindly suggest that our situation be reviewed for our reinstatement fee of \$600.00 to be waived. We are trying to resolve the long lasting mail problem by obtaining a P.O Box, and we claim responsibility for this part. The account will be replaced as soon as possible. We are taking every precaution to make sure that this, or any other similar event never takes place again. Your time and help is greatly appreciated. Thank you for your prompt attention.
