ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SUPERNOVA FARMS, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapter 607, the undersigned, being a natural person, hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: Supernova Farms, Inc.
Its business shall be carried on in the State of Florida, in the
United States of America, in Central America, in South America, in
Europe and elsewhere, as may be authorized by its Board of
Directors.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation shall be that provided below:

- (a) To sue and be sued, complain, and defend in its corporate name;
- (b) To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at will and to use it or a facsimile of it, by impressing or affixing it or in any other manner reproducing it;
- (c) To purchase, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal with real or personal property or any legal or equitable interest in property wherever located:
- (d) To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property;
- (e) To lend money to, and use its credit to assist, its officers and employees in accordance with Florida Statute 607.0833;
- (f) To purchase, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire; own, hold, vote, use, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of; and deal in and with shares or other interests in, or obligations of, any other entity;
- (g) To make contracts and guarantees, incur liabilities, borrow money, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations (which may be convertible into or include the option to purchase other securities of the corporation),

and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of any of its property, franchises, and income and make contracts of guaranty and suretyship which are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business of a corporation the majority of the outstanding stock of which is owned, directly or indirectly, by the contracting corporation; a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, a majority of the outstanding stock of the contracting corporation; or a corporation the majority of the outstanding stock of which is owned, directly or indirectly, by a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, the majority of the outstanding stock of the contracting corporation, which contracts of guaranty and suretyship shall be deemed to be necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or -attainment of the business of the contracting corporation, and make other contracts of guaranty and suretyship which are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business of the contracting corporation;

- (h) To lend money, invest and reinvest in funds, and receive and hold real and personal property as security for repayment;
- (i) To conduct its business, locate offices, and exercise the powers granted by this act within or without this state;
- (j) To elect directors and appoint officers, employees, and agents of the corporation and define their duties, fix their compensation, and lend them money and credit;
- (k) To make and amend bylaws, not inconsistent with its articles of incorporation or with the laws of this state, for managing the business and regulating the affairs of the corporation;
- (1) To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable,, scientific, or educational purposes;
- (m) To transact any lawful business that will aid governmental policy;
- (n) To make payments or donations or do any other act not inconsistent with law that furthers the business and affairs of the corporation;
- (o) To pay pensions and establish pension plans, pension trusts, profit-sharing plans, share bonus plans, share option plans, and benefit or incentive plans for any or all of its current or former directors, officers, employees, and agents and for any or all of the current

or former directors, officers, employees, and agents of its subsidiaries.

- To provide insurance for its benefit on the life of any (p) of its directors, officers, or employees, or on the life of any shareholder for the purpose of acquiring at his death shares of its stock owned by the shareholder or by the spouse or children of the shareholder;
- To be a promoter, incorporator, partner, member, associate, or manager of any corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other entity; and (a)
- To do any act authorized by law. (\mathbf{r})

ARTICLE III

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be one hundred (100) shares of common stock at no par value.

ARTICLE IV


ARTICLE VIII



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
