ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

NEWTOWN COMMUNICATIONS OF JACKSONVILLE

SON SERVING ON STATE The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, here forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, effective September 1, 1999.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is NEWTOWN COMMUNICATIONS OF JACKSONVILLE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of this business to be transacted by this corporation is sales of pagers, accessories, airtime, and related miscellaneous services, and:

- 1. To engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State.
- 2. To the same extent as a natural person might or could do, to purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds, and any interest, estate, and rights in real property, and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.
- 3. To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise to dispose of, and to invest in and deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property and services of every class, kind and description, now or hereafter permitted by law.
- 4. To conduct business in, have one or more offices in and to buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose or real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses, in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries.
- 5. To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and to execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate indebtedness as required.
- 6. To purchase the corporation assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.
- 7. To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of the share of the capital stock of, and any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida, or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.
