THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, F.S. Chapter 607, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is HO 100, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL ADDRESS

and the mailing address of the corporation shall be the same.

ARTICLE III - COMMENCEMENT

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

ARTICLE V - CAPITAL STOCK

(a) the fact such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Board of Directors or committee which authorizes, approves or ratifies the contractor transaction by vote or consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the votes or consents of such interested Director; or (b) the fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Shareholders entitled to vote and they authorize, approve or ratify such contract or transaction by vote or written consent; or (c) the contract is fair and reasonable to the Corporation.

Common or interested Directors may be counted in determing the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board of Directors or committee thereof which authorizes, approves or ratifies such contract or transaction.

ARTICLE XIV - TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation is to exist perpetually.
