Pursuant to Section 607.1403 Florida Statutes, the undersigned hereby executes these Articles of Dissolution and provides as follows:

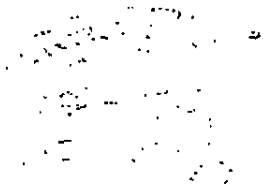
1. The name of this corporation is: **PANTHER INVESTMENTS TECHNOLOGY, INC.**
