To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed with this letter is a completed Corporate Reinstatement Form and a check for \$450 for Our Takeout Express, Inc. Our Takeout Express, Inc. (the "company") requests that the Department of State exempt it from the penalty provision of the fee for reinstatement.

The company moved offices in early 2000 and the regular notice for filing its annual report was not received. The company is a new corporation with only two officers and directors who are responsible for its day-to-day management and its long-term planning. This makes it difficult for company management to ensure compliance with all applicable regulations. For this reason, the company was not aware of the requirement for filing annual reports or the requirement to keep its address current with the Department of State. In addition, the cost of reinstatement places a financial burden on a company this size and relative age. For these reasons, the company requests that the Department consider exempting it from the penalty provision of the reinstatement fee.
