THE UNDERSIGNED do hereby associate together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida under the corporate name of THE FOUNDATION FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT INCORPORATED and hereby set forth and declare:

CHARTER

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be THE FOUNDATION FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT INCORPORATED, located at Fort Myers, County of Lee, State of Florida.

ARTICLE II

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

The amount of the capital stock of this Corporation shall be 100 shares of \$ 10.00 par value stock, which said stock shall be non-assessable to be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine. All of the capital stock shall be common stock.
