ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

APEX INTERNATIONAL SOLUTIONS, INC.

These articles are filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida providing for the formation, rights, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of corporations for profit.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

APEX INTERNATIONAL SOLUTIONS, INC.

ARTICLE II - MANAGEMENT BY SHAREHOLDERS

All corporate power shall be exercised exclusively by or under the authority of the shareholders, and the business and affairs of this corporation shall be managed under the direction of the shareholders.
