INFOQUEST SOLUTIONS, INC. PLAN OF LIQUIDATION AND DISSOLUTION

- 1. The officers are authorized to sell any or all of the assets, if any, of the Corporation for such prices and on such terms as the officers deem appropriate.
- 2. The officers shall wind up the affairs of the Corporation, shall collect its assets, shall pay or provide for its liabilities and shall establish a reserve (if deemed appropriate) to meet known liabilities and liquidating expenses and estimated unascertained or contingent liabilities and contingent expenses.
- 3. The officers shall distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation (subject to any remaining liabilities) to the shareholders in exchange for their shares.
