
Dear Ms. Prathers:

As I mentioned to you on the phone yesterday, we incorporated our very small company, First Choice Home Inspection and Construction Services, Inc on 11/04/99. Much to our own inexperience and ignorance, we failed to provide the state with the required documents and fees regarding our corporation. I understand that we should have received a Reinstatement Notice in June and September 2000, however, I do not remember receiving them (although I am not saying that we did not receive them – I just do not remember receiving them). We received the completed and enclosed Reinstatement Notice at the time I learned I was pregnant. Unfortunately, I have had several complications with this pregnancy, which has diverted our attention from our business responsibilities to our health and family responsibilities.
