### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

### GEORGE E. RUDD, P.A.

The undersigned incorporator who is a member of the Florida Bar duly licensed to render services as an attorney under the laws of the State of Florida, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation Act and other laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

### <u>ARTICLE I – NAME</u>

The name of this professional service corporation shall be: GEORGE E. RUDD, P.A.

### ARTICLE II – DURATION

The period of this professional service corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE III – COMMENCEMENT DATE

Corporate existence will commence on the date of the filing of these articles.

### <u>ARTICLE IV – PURPOSE</u>
