SUBJECT: Request for one time waiver for dissolution/revocation of corporation

1. This letter is to request a one-time waiver of the dissolution/revocation of our corporation, TOWNSENDS, INC.
2. We began our family corporation on 23 Nov 99, and are brand new to this experience. Based upon our inexperience, we hired an attorney to set up the corporation and an auditor to do the taxes. We were told by our lawyer in Nov 99 that we needed to renew the corporation every year with the state, and that it would cost \$150.00. We asked him when we needed to renew it, and he said the state would send out a notice. About two months ago, we asked our auditor about the renewal, and he said that he believed it was in Jan, but that we would get something in the mail from the state. Since the corporation was still less than a year old, we (mistakenly) were not overly concerned.

On 11 Oct 00, we received the red & white notice of dissolution/revocation in the mail. This is without a doubt, the first correspondence we have received from the state about our corporation. On 12 Oct 00, I called your office to check to what address the first two notices had been sent, and they confirmed they had our correct address.

We are in the Air Force, stationed at Hurlburt Field, FL, and have a P.O. Box on base. This is the address where we receive both corporation and personal mail. I have had a couple problems with our post office in the past, where they failed to deliver items, and instead returned them to the sender. This is one possible explanation as to why we never received the notices. If that is the case, it may be possible for your office to verify that our notices were returned. Additionally, it may be possible that the notices were mistakenly sent to our lawyer's office, since he was initially listed as our "registered agent". He does however, deny receiving the notices, but perhaps your office could check on that as well.

3. The bottom line is that we just started this corporation and would have never intentionally allowed it to default. Again, we are new to this, but thought we were asking the right questions. While \$750.00 may not seem like a lot of money to some folks, it is to us. This is just a small family (grama, dad, son & daughter) venture. We are now completely aware of the rules and will make sure that this never happens again. Thank you for your consideration.
