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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

NAME, PRINCIPAL OFFICE, AND MAILING ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is St. Johns River Anesthesia & Pain, P.A. The corporation's initial principal office and mailing address are located at 6500 Crill Avenue, Suite 4, Palatka, Florida 32177.

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is hereby organized as a professional corporation under Chapter 621 of the Florida Statutes (hereby referred to as the "Professional Service Corporation Act" or the "Act") for the sole and specific purpose of engaging in and transacting every aspect of rendering the same professional services to the public that a doctor of anesthesia and pain management, duly licensed under the laws of the state of Florida, is authorized to render to the public. Consistent with the intent for this corporation to constitute a professional corporation under the Act, the following provisions shall apply:

(a) This corporation may not render professional services except through its officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services within this state; provided, however, this provision shall not be interpreted to include in the term "employee", clerks, secretaries, bookkeepers, technicians, and other assistants who are not usually and ordinarily considered by custom and practice to be rendering professional services to the public for which a license or other legal authorization is required.

(b) Any officer, agent or employee of this corporation shall be personally liable and accountable only for negligent or wrongful acts or misconduct committed by that person, or by any person under that person's direct supervision and control, while rendering professional service on behalf of the corporation to the person for whom such professional services were being rendered.

(c) This corporation shall not engage in any business other than the rendering of the professional services for which it was specifically organized; provided, however, nothing in the Act or in any other provisions of existing law applicable to corporations shall be interpreted to prohibit this corporation from investing its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investments, or from owning real or personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

(d) This corporation may not issue any of its capital stock to anyone other than a professional corporation, a professional limited liability company, or an individual who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same specific professional services as those for which the corporation was incorporated. No shareholder of this corporation shall enter into a voting trust agreement or any other

type agreement vesting another person with the authority to exercise the voting power of any or all of that person's stock.

(e) If any officer, shareholder, agent or employee of this corporation who has been rendering professional service to the public becomes legally disqualified to render such professional services within this state or accepts employment that, pursuant to existing law, places restrictions or limitations upon that person's continued rendering of such professional services, that person shall sever all employment with, and financial interests in, this corporation forthwith.

(f) No shareholder of this corporation may sell or transfer her or his shares in such corporation except to another professional corporation, professional limited liability company, or individual, each of which must be eligible to be a shareholder of such corporation.

(g) This corporation shall exchange shares or merge only with other domestic professional corporations or limited liability companies organized under the Act to render the same specific professional service, and a merger or consolidation with any foreign corporation or limited liability company is prohibited.

ARTICLE III

CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue Seventy Five Hundred (7500) shares of common stock having a par value of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) per share, which shares shall be and hereby are designated as "Common Shares".

ARTICLE IV

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual, commencing on November 22, 1999.

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The initial registered office of this corporation in the State of Florida is 233 E. Bay Street, Suite 620, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation is Dennis E. Hayes. The Board of Directors may, from time to time, change the registered agent or move the registered office to any other address in Florida.

ARTICLE VI

INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have two (2) Directors initially. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased, from time to time, by amendment to the Bylaws, but in

AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. B. Any obligation that the Corporation may issue or sell which is convertible into or exchangeable for any stock of the Corporation of any class or classes, or to which is attached or pertinent any warrant or warrants or other instruments conferring on the holder the right to subscribe for or purchase from the Corporation any shares of its stock of any class or classes.

This right shall be deemed waived by any Shareholder who does not exercise it and pay for the shares preempted within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice from the Corporation stating the price, terms and conditions of the issue of shares and inviting the Shareholder to exercise this preemptive right. This right may also be waived by a written waiver signed by the Shareholder.
