Dear Ms. Williams:

Pursuant to your instructions, enclosed you will find copy of the letters sent to you and dated November 21, 2000; December 22, 2000 and January 31, 2001; along with the copy of the letters received from the DOS and the checks that were sent along with the letters above described.


We were asking for a waiver of the late fees for the Uniform Business Report for the year 2000, which was granted by the Department of State in letter dated January 10, 2001.
