ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator for the purpose of creating a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE




