#### 1. ACTION TO DISSOLVE

# 1.1. Action to Dissolve this Corporation Pursuant Section 607.1402(6) of the Florida Statutes

### 1.1.1. Margaret Farmer, the sole shareholder of this corporation, shall take action to dissolve PediTech, Inc. (Document #P99000104986), a Florida domestic profit corporation, pursuant to section 607.1402(6) of the Florida Statutes. Action taken under this section must be by written consent describing the action, dated and signed by the approving shareholders having the requisite number of votes of each voting group entitled to vote thereon. This written consent must be delivered to the principal office of the corporation within 60 days of the date the sole shareholder signed this written consent for this written consent to be effective, pursuant to section 607.0704(1) of the Florida Statutes. A consent signed under this section has the effect of a meeting vote pursuant to section 607.0704(4) of the Florida Statutes.

### 1.2. Dissolution by Written Consent of the Shareholders

1.2.1. Margaret Farmer, the sole shareholder of this corporation, consents to dissolve PediTech, Inc. (Document #P99000104986), a Florida domestic profit corporation, effective April 1, 2001, pursuant to section 607.1402(6) of the Florida Statutes. Since Margaret Farmer is the sole shareholder of all shares of all classes of outstanding stock, all shareholders entitled to vote have approved and consented to the dissolution of this corporation, evidenced by her signature below.
