The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is Mortgage Educators of America, Inc.

### ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

# ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The preemptive right of any holder is determined by a ratio of the authorized and issued shares of common stock held by the holder of all shares of common stock currently authorized and issued.

The shareholders of the corporation shall be allowed to vote their shares cumulatively so as to give one candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected, multiplied by the number of his shares, to distribute them among as many candidates as he may wish.
